A Guide to New State Regulations Impacting the Cost of Drinking Water

New York State regulators have determined that decades of pollution caused by the manufacturers of the compounds 1,4-dioxane, PFOS and PFOA pose a long-term threat to the groundwater that provides 100% of Long Island's drinking water. Making sure these contaminants are removed from groundwater before we supply water to your home or business is expected to cost in the range of \$20 - \$30 million.

The New York State Department of Health recently enacted new requirements on water providers at 10 ppt (parts per trillion) for PFOA and 10 ppt for PFOS and 1 part per billion for 1,4-dioxane. The MCLs are among the most protective levels in the nation.

That is why, as of January 1, 2021, you will see an increase of approximately 26 cents per day in your bill. This new charge will help pay for the cost of developing and operating treatment systems for the three contaminants of concern that are now being regulated by New York State.

Though raising the amount we charge you for water service is something we try to avoid whenever possible, our top priority is to provide you with high quality drinking water that meets or surpasses all drinking water standards.

The new state regulations will be the toughest in the country for these contaminants and as a result, you can be assured that you will continue to have some of the best drinking water available.

We have pursued and been awarded state grant funds, but they alleviate only a portion of the cost of needed treatment systems. We are also taking the companies responsible for the pollution to court to hold them accountable for the costs of removing these contaminants. We expect both these measures to ultimately have a positive impact on water rates.

SPECIAL PROVISIONS

1. The rate set forth above shall be effective only with respect to hydrants not served under a state, municipal or federal contract.
2. Request for the installation of public fire hydrants must be made in writing, by an authorized official of the municipality, specifying the exact location of the required hydrant. Where request is made to change the location or move a hydrant, the entire expense of the work must be borne by the municipality requesting the change.
3. Water may be taken from any public hydrant only by duly authorized members of a fire company, which, pursuant to a contract, is providing fire protection to a municipality which is located wholly or partly within the Authority District, or of another fire company, which, pursuant to a mutual aid agreement, is providing such protection, for the sole purpose of extinguishing fires. Water shall not be taken from any public fire hydrant, either by duly authorized members of one of such fire departments or by any other person for any purpose other than extinguishing fires, unless specifically authorized by the Authority.

SPECIAL PROVISIONS - PRIVATE FIRE PROTECTION

1. All water used for fire protection only.
2. Contracts remain in force from the date thereof but may be terminated by the customer upon thirty (30) day's notice.

Water for any other purpose shall not be drawn from a private connection, except that the Authority will permit the use of water for test purposes upon three (3) days prior notification to the Authority. The use of water in violation of the terms of this provision shall result in cancellation of service under this classification, whereupon the customer shall be rendered service under metered Water Service Class No. 1 to 5, as applicable and shall be at the rates set forth therein.
3. Customers requiring private fire protection must supply, install and maintain, at customer's expense a fire meter or a detector check valve with by-pass meter on the fire service line.
